

Budget Proposals should be complete in all respects properly categorized and HS Codes for each commodity must be provided.

It may be noted that the budget proposals should be sent in the light of the following:

Justification given in favour of the proposals shall k : restricted to 300 words and Annexures should be used, if necessary.

Each Division should select 3-5 proposals, which are considered most crucial to the sector.

Issues discussed year after year but never agreed to,  $m_{\ell}$  y not be raised again.

Proposals, which are related to other Ministries/Depart nents, need not be considered and should be sent to the concerned Ministry /Department for necessary action. There is a serious fiscal crisis. Therefore, proposals of small reduction/exemption in custom/excise duties, service tax etc. should be avoic ed unless they are absolutely necessary if such reduction/exemption are necessary, t en ample justification should be given.

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vii. Where temporary relief has been given to some sector for particular period (i.e. up to 31st March, 2016), then it should be re-examined and views may be dibmitted on these as well.
