<b>6.</b>	<b>Description of the content:</b> Requirement to declare physico - chemical composition of fertilizers that are imported and marketed in the country is <b>established</b> . Its purpose is Establish requirements for manufacturers, importers and distributors of fertilizers to declare on the packaging or label or on the packaging or label, or on the corresponding ballots, invoices or shipping guides for solid fertilizers in bulk, the physicochemical composition of the product , Both as regards fertilizers, accompanying elements as heavy metals and other specific physicochemical parameters according to the type and nature of the fertilizer such as solubility granulometry, pH, among others.  Thus, by establishing greater demands on the physicochemical composition of the fertilizers imported, manufactured and marketed in the country, the information available to agricultural producers using these inputs will be improved and, on the other hand, Will result in an optimization of the quality of the fertilizers, a situation that will be verified by the SAG through inspection actions.
