The Collegiate Board of the National Sanitary Surveillance Agency, in the use of attributions that confer the 15, III and IV allied to the art. 7, III, and IV, of Law No. 9,782, of June 26, January 1999, art. 53, III, §§ 1 and 3 of the Internal Regulations approved in accordance with Annex I of the Resolution of the Collegiate Board of Directors - RDC n ° 61, of February 3, 2016, and with a view to the provisions of art. 35 of Decree No. 3,029 of April 16, 1999, resolves to submit for consultation public comments and suggestions from the general public, a proposal for a normative act in Annex, as resolved at a meeting held on November 28, 2017, and myself, Director-Chairman, I determine its publication.

Art. 1 It is open, from the date of publication of this Public Consultation, the period of 30 (thirty) days for the presentation of criticisms and suggestions regarding the proposed Resolution providing for the **inclusion** of non-agricultural use in industrial yards, transmission lines, electrical distribution and telephone cables, gas pipelines and nature conservation areas., for the active ingredient **T28.1 - TRICLOPIR-BUTOTYLIC (TRICLOPYR-BUTOTYL)**, contained in the Monographs List of Active Ingredients of Agrochemicals, Household Cleaning and Preserving of Wood, published by Resolution - RE No. 165, of August 29, 2003, DOU of September 2, 2003.

Art. 3. Once the term stipulated in art. 1st, the National Health Surveillance Agency will promote the analysis of the contributions and, after the deliberation of the Collegiate Board,

will provide the result of the public consultation on Anvisa's website.

Single paragraph. The Agency may, as necessary and for reasons of convenience and opportunity, to articulate with the organs and entities involved and those who have expressed interest in this matter to subsidize subsequent technical discussions and deliberation end of the Collegiate Board
