manufacturers or importers, in order to conduct the necessary tests and ensure their conformity with the requirements of this decision

Take the appropriate procedures in the face of the product of the one who is not the availability of the conditions for granting a 3.
certificate of conformity or who loses any condition of them, including the suspension of trading and withdraw its from local markets
Obliging provider responsible for infringing product launch, to summon him and withdrawn from local markets, and straighten conditions if 4.
possible, or forcing him to return to the country of origin or destroyed in accordance with the applicable laws in this regard, within the time
period specified by the Commission or the competent authority As appropriate

to evaluate the matching product, according to the decision of the Council of Ministers on the system of e Maratea to control the points of
conformity assessment

This decision does not prevent inspectors from the competent authorities to monitor and take samples to conduct checks on the product in 4.
