Subject: Annual Declaration on Anticipated Activities (ADAA) for the year 2026 — regarding.

Sir/Madam,

The Chemical Weapons Convention Act 2000(the Act), extends to the whole of India, and it shall apply to—

- (a) citizens of India outside India; and
- (b) associates, branches or subsidiaries, outside India of companies or bodies corporate, registered or incorporated in India.

Under the Act, every State Party is obligated, inter alia, to submit to the OPCW, every year "Annual Declaration on Anticipated Activities" (ADAA), which shall contain an account of the main activities in which the chemical firm situated, propose to undertake during the next calendar year. Towards this purpose, all chemical firms which undertake production, processing and consumption of Schedule 2 chemicals and those which propose to undertake production of Schedule 3 chemicals in the next calendar year have to submit their individual ADAA to their respective National Authority. The declaration thresholds set by the Convention are as follows:

- a. 1 Kg. of a chemical designated * in Schedule 2, Part A;
- b. 100 Kg. of any other chemical listed in Schedule 2, Part A;
- c. 1 Tonne of a chemical listed in Schedule 2, Part B; or
- d. >30 tonnes of a Schedule 3 chemical

2. In fulfilment of this obligation and in compliance to relevant provisions of the Chemical Weapons Convention Act of 2000, every chemical facility dealing with Schedule 2 and Schedule 3 chemicals is required to submit the ADAA of 2026 before 30th September 2025. The ADAA of 2026 should be filed online at the URL <<https://cwc.nacwc.nic.in>>, which will be kept open from **1100 Hrs. of 1st September to 1100 Hrs. of 30th September, 2025** for this purpose. Online filed declaration authenticated by Digital Signature Certification (DSC) or e-sign is mandatory in ADAA-2026. In order to ensure that Chemical Facilities aware of their statutory liabilities, the NACWC shall also bring out a Public Notice in leading newspapers/ chemical journals, urging the concerned persons/ firms to submit their individual ADAAs specifying the mode, time schedules and other details of submission (copy attached).

3. I may also remind you that submission of ADAA has to be submitted/ filed in the proforma prescribed, with complete and accurate information and within the time limit as prescribed above. Failure to do so is a criminal offence under the CWC Act, 2000.
